

## Course Outline: Fire Warden (Incl. Basic Firefighting)

### Course Overview:

This course provides learners with the knowledge and skills needed to act as a Fire Warden in the workplace. You will learn about the science of fire, legal requirements, and fire prevention measures, as well as how to respond safely in an emergency.

The training combines classroom-based theory with practical sessions, including live fire extinguisher use, fire risk assessment, and evacuation drills.

### Learning Outcomes / Key Topics

By the end of this course, you will be able to:

- Understand how fire starts and develops (elements of combustion, classifications of fire, heat transmission).
- Identify workplace fire hazards and take preventative action.
- Take correct actions in the event of a fire emergency.
- Select and safely use the right fire extinguisher for different types of fire.
- Recognise legal requirements and responsibilities under fire safety legislation.
- Carry out a basic fire risk assessment and workplace fire inspection.
- Understand fire safety arrangements, escape plans, and signage.
- Perform the role of a Fire Warden, including day-to-day duties and emergency responsibilities.
- Assist with safe evacuation and communicate effectively with the Person in Charge (PIC) and emergency services.

- Fire Fighting Techniques
- PPE and Safety protocols
